News and Notes

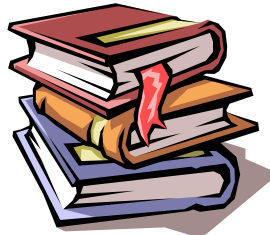

Campus News

John Carroll University held their Formal Recruitment the weekend of September 20-22. They had 140 women sign up for the event and 120 attend the final set of parties. This was an increase from last year. Thank you to Alison Borodkin, Julia Lazar, Kathy Imbler, Rhonda Planchet, and Nancy Toth for helping the Potential New Members enter their final selections on September 22.

Baldwin Wallace University also held their Formal Recruitment in September. Marc West, BWU Director of Greek Life, amongst other things, and member of Delta Sigma Phi, reached out to CAPA for help, because Annalise Sinclair, one of his grad assistants, also interns at John Carroll University for JCU Greek Life Director Holly Mittelmeier. Annalise is a member of Alpha Omicron Pi, University of South Florida-Tampa.

BW experienced about a 25% increase in women going through formal sorority recruitment compared to last year. 197 Potential New Members started recruitment and about 140 women attended preference parties. Quota was expected to be between 22-28 new members.
