Convention Report

Thank you for allowing me the honor of representing our alumnae chapter at the Delta Delta Delta Convention in Phoenix, Arizona this past July.

It was an immersive two-and-a-half-day experience full of boundless excitement including sisterhood, celebrating and legislating with new and old friends. I am grateful to have gained an immense knowledge about the workings of our Fraternity. My best memory will be the palpable strength of the bonds amongst our Fraternity's membership and the effervescence of the women I met - from collegians to Diamond Circle initiates (three!).

All 45 proposed Bylaw Amendments were passed by 217 collegiate and alumnae voting delegates. Significant amendments included 1) a change of the title Executive Director to Chief Executive Officer, keeping in step with other Panhellenic organizations, and 2) allowing the Fraternity to seek out a qualified candidate for the

CEO position. Previously, the Executive Director was required to be a Tri Delta member.

New Executive Board officers were installed, and our very own **Kristi Horner**, *Denison*, retired from her national-level volunteer role as Leadership Development Committee (LDC) Chair. Her many accomplishments were celebrated during the International Pansy Breakfast.

Of course, being from Cleveland, the city of champions, our alumnae chapter swept three award categories: Alumnae Excellence in Communication

for a medium chapter size; Alumnae Philanthropy With Purpose (other) for a medium chapter size; and DRUM ROLL, PLEASE! the most outstanding, singular award – Crescent Award – distinguishing our alumnae chapter as THE top alumnae chapter overall! As the award reads, we exhibit "exceptional and rewarding experiences to (our) members while maintaining a stable or increasing membership, promoting Life Loyal membership, and offering diversity of activities and schedules. (Our) chapter reflects the commitment of lifetime membership experience and the Purpose of Tri Delta."



For these awards, we received certificates and credit towards at least one free registration for the 2018 Convention in Dallas, Texas.

MetroHealth Update

MetroHealth has been busy this summer with the grand opening of the Brecksville Health & Surgery Center; the onsite medical support for the 2016 Republican National Convention; and their third annual "Preemie Day" celebration. In July, the new Critical Care Pavilion opened as part of the main medical campus transformation.

Last year, in addition to donations of children's books and handmade fleece pillowcases, both our alumnae chapter and Tri Delta Bridge-A-Rama gave generously to the MetroHealth Foundation. In addition to proceeds from the March "Mad for Metro" event, funds were raised through bridge playing fees and direct donations. These monies were used to purchase school supplies for patients. 
