In honor of Linda Geca Barath's position as Treasurer of CAPA, 2018-19, a feature about her sorority, Theta Phi Alpha, uncovers info about the group's founding, longevity, and sisterhood. Plus, its headquarters' residing in Cuyahoga County makes it a first for CAPA. With 58 active collegiate chapters, Theta Phi's headquarters provides national leadership from Bay Village, OH.

Theta Phi Alpha, one of 26 national sororities participating in the National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) is a women's fraternity founded at The University of Michigan, of Ann Arbor, MI, on August 30, 1912.

Linda earned her degree in accounting from Cleveland State University in 1979, where she joined the Alpha Xi chapter of Theta Phi Alpha and served as treasurer. Through the years, she has served many volunteer

positions with Theta Phi locally and nationally.

In fact, Linda was key in locating Theta Phi's first permanent national offices to Bay Village, OH, at which time she served as Theta Phi Alpha's National Treasurer. She also helped find and move the location to its current spot in Bay Village.

Theta Phi Alpha's apt motto says: "Nothing great is ever achieved without much enduring," and its symbol is the compass, and mascot, a penguin. Philanthropy projects include The House That Theta Phi Alpha Built to provide aid to the homeless through shelters; Camp Friendship summer camp for disadvantaged children; and Glenmary Home Missioners serving rural Appalachia.
